- 1. Meeting was called to order at 5:34pm (AZ Time) by Michael Eckert, Board Chairman. Board members present were Gary Engman and Wade Warden, A quorum was present. Attendance list attached.
- 2. Minutes from prior meeting were discussed. Meeting minutes were sent to all board members, approved and posted on PEDWID website. No further discussion.
- 3. Treasurer Report: Mr. Hinesly sent October financials overview to all board members prior to the meeting. Financial were reviewed and approved. See attachments. No further discussion.
- 4. Water System Operator Report: Mr. Anderson provide updates on the current system. All monthly sampling completed. Replaced one meter due to gasket on freeze plate failing. See attached report.

- 1. New Well, Holding Tank Site and WIFA Loans The project manager, Mr. Anderson, provided an overview and update of the current new well project. Ground breaking on the new well site is projected to start the first week of December. Engineered plans submitted to Navajo County and permits were issued for the new tank Site & mainline extension. Tank vendor currently manufacturing panels for installation. See attached reports for specific details.
- 2. Well pump replacement cost on the current well was \$6,500. Cost was within the allotted budget. Well production is back up to a consistent 24.5 GPM.
- 3. Mr. Engman provided the board with cost information to advertise in the Sunshine Newsletter for DWID functions. Newsletter covers Pinedale & Clay Springs communities. Cost for a ¼ page is \$24. No action taken.
- 4. Next board meeting will be on 18 Dec at 5:30pm. Motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:09pm by Mr. Eckert. Second by Mr. Warden, accepted by all board members.
